Saira Banu, Assistant Coordinator, IQAC, from the Research Centre of English, highlighted the importance of nonverbal communication using gestures and postures in class rooms and off the class. She hammered the idea of grafting and keeping the attention of students very effectively using positive body language, which can be used for better presentation.

The Fourth Session of the Induction Programme was presented by Dr. J. Asnet Mary, Assistant Professor of the Department of Zoology.

The fifth session was spiced with psychological inputs from Dr. Sr. Francis Paulin, the student Counsellor and Former Secretary of Fatima College. She emphasized that identification of one's own feeling is very important for self-awareness. She spoke about Self-Awareness, Self-Management, Self-Motivation, Empathy and Social Skills.

The sixth session of Staff Induction Programme was handled by Rev. Sr.Emily Joseph, the student Counsellor and Former Provincial, St. Joseph of Lyons Indian Province, entitled "The power within you". Sister talked about Emotional Intelligence and its role. Initially Sister listed out the different types of intelligence like what feels good, what feels bad, and how to get move from bad to good.

The day ended with the session presented by Dr. Vasantha Esther Rani, Head, Research Centre of Home Science with Food Biotechnology, who gave pearls of wisdom on research and the various funding agencies that are supporting researchers. A brief outline was given on the preparation, submission and presentation of research proposals, bringing to the audience a personal touch to it. Perhaps, to her, research is not a single affair but buds from every day experiences and lessons from in and out.

The third day programme – 30th June was flagged off by Dr. S. J. Kala of the Research Centre of English who spoke about innovativeness in teaching. The past, present and future were synchronised and the demands of the present age were delicately conveyed to the members. One needs love and passion to perform creatively in classroom environment.

Dr. S. Vidya, the IQAC Co-ordinator, gave a deeper perspective of NAAC, NIRF explaining their complete process from applying to assessment. She highlighted the role of teacher in the whole process of taking the institution to the next level and the



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responsibility that every individual holds by contributing for the growth of the institution creating a win-win scenario.

Dr. Mary Magdalene Abraham gave a mind blowing session on classroom etiquette and class control.

The Faculty Induction Programme prepared the young staff to take up new challenges, to learn and to teach, by emulating the best practices shared with them by their experienced colleagues. The programme left them with renewed zeal and forever to work for Fatima College, to bloom where they are planted

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

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

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

The Faculty Induction Programme for the newly recruited faculty was organized by the IQAC of Fatima College from 15/06/2017 – 22/06/2017. The main aim of the programme was to initiate the faculty into the culture of their new workplace, to introduce them to their new roles and responsibilities and to prepare them to face the awaiting challenges with the right attitude and utmost dedication to work.

The **seven-day programme** started prayerfully, with a song by Dr. Sarah Evangelin, and prayer by Dr. Sr. Biji. The **Coordinator of IQAC, Dr. Auxilia Felicitas welcomed the gathering**. She introduced the Secretary and the Principal, the two important pillars of the College, to the participants. Then she briefly stated the purpose of the Induction Programme.

The Principal Dr. Sr. Celine Sahaya Mary expressed her happiness in meeting the new faculty, who, she hoped, would work with a sense of commitment and responsibility and rise up to the high standards set for them as bench mark.

The induction started with the session by **our Secretary Dr. Sr. Francisca Flora** on the topic **"St. Joseph's Culture and Legacy".** She gave a special explanation to the sublimity and greatness of the creation of God and highlighted how man is just a microcosm of the Macrocosm of the Universe, its Galaxies.

Dr. Alexander Pravin, Department of Commerce, Dean of the School of Management Studies, St. Joseph's College, Trichy, and external expert of our IQAC, was the resource person for the session on 17/06/2017. She listed out some of the qualities of a teacher. Appropriate dress code, communication skills and courteous manners play a vital role in the physical and emotional grooming of a professional teacher. She also gave suggestions as to how a teacher can move on from being a good teacher to a great teacher. She introduced the five 'C's approach to teaching: Collaboration, Communication, Critical thinking, Creativity and Caring.

The sixth day's session was presented by **Dr. Shyamala, Head of the PG Department of Information and Technology,** on 21/06/2017. The topic of the day was "Group **Dynamics and Team Building**". She focused on four points:

- 1) Why we need teamwork?
- 2) Qualities of teamwork
- 3) How to build a team work?
- 4) Stages in team building.

Dr. Sami had enlisted three important roles of higher education:



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
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1. Expansion

Rev. Father Joe Arun delivered a lively session on the Avalanche in Teaching-Learning process today and ahead in the world of fast developing technological scenario. Teaching is not transfer of knowledge but a teacher is "Behaviour Transference". Teaching is a passion and institutions grow by passionate teachers not by building bricks. A good teacher cannot be trained since teaching is not a profession, it's a passion. A teacher's decorum impacts the students. Teaching is a constantly changing process and a teacher should change to equip oneself. How to change? The attitude of a teacher on life or the environment has an impact on the student. Positive attitude radiates positive energy and there is growth in world view.

The next most important factor for a teacher is "Health". A healthy mind forms a healthy body and together makes a Happy Teacher. Meditation, exercise, good eating habits and and nutritious food are necessary for a teacher. To nurture all these a teacher should have a wonderful, happy and peaceful home. Rev. Joe Arun illustrate all these factors that make a Healthy and happy teacher whose very presence throws happiness and pleasure of a class on each student. A teacher plays a vital role in character formation of each of her student. Her prime aim is to form an Able, Capable and Employable graduate. Besides these Life Skills should also be taught to them to make them Marriageable.

He also pointed out that virtual learning is creeping fast through digitalization and online courses in Higher education institutions. Hence atteacher should follow three ways of learning in all ways of teaching – 1) to thirst to know the new 2) to question assumptions and 3) to know one's own self. The session ended with an excellent quote "Minds are parachutes, they work best when open ".

Dr. Alexander PravinDurai is our college IQAC External Expert. He gave a detailed talk on New Higher education policies. He said that the Institutions of Higher Education will ranked and categorized on a global level. There are three ranking categories:

- 1) Institution of Intellectual Ranking to compete with global research, patents and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)
- 2) Institution of Economic Ranking Hi-tech teaching tools, produce professionals
- 3) Institution of Social Ranking provide education for the socially backward classes

 The New Higher education policies cater to the above ranking. The following are the highlights of the same
- 1) Knowledge should be converted into skills
- 2) Education should be "for profit "institutions
- 3) Performance based funding in future
- 4) Move from permanence to performance
- 5) Vocational courses skill based papers formed in accordance with NSDC (National Skill Development Council) train students and output evaluated by SSC (Sector Skill Certificate)
- 6) Placement Assurance coordination with leading companies- Public Private Partnership (PPP)
- 7) Teacher training in Higher Education
- 8) Credit transfer systems –Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC) for distance online learning
- 9) Education to be globalized Foreign exchange courses
- 10) Research is outcome based (i) impact factor (ii) patents

Following the details of the new policies, Dr. Alexander suggested a few Best Practices:

- 1) Life skills acquisition introduce life skills for first years
- 2) ICT infusion e-content video shoot class room teaching



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3) Library – 30 hours per paper for each student outside class – monitor and give relevant assignments on this . Give internal marks + 5 marks for attendance

4) Internship compulsory

5) Self-learning paper one compulsory – one staff for it (no work load) but exam/evaluation by

the staff

6) Comprehensive viva – UG – 2 credits

7) M.Phil. – e-content all papers.

Based on the expected changes in Higher education, a college should identify the strengths of each department and build a Brand Value for the college to meet the global challenges. With regards to the weaknesses, new strategies and plans have to be rigorously implemented to raise the quality. Thus, this eye-opening session through the doors open for each staff to work on the challenges that lie ahead of this Centre of Potential.

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
