The main objectives of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) are as under:

- i. To engage the faculty and students of Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) in identifying development issues in rural areas and finding sustainable solutions for the same.
- ii. Identify & select existing innovative technologies, enable customisation of technologies, or devise implementation method for innovative solutions, as required by the people.
- iii. To allow HEIs to contribute to devising systems for smooth implementation of various Government programmes.

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0 is the upgraded version of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 1.0. The scheme is extended to all educational institutes; however under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0 Participating institutes are selected based on the fulfilment of certain criteria.

State-wise details regarding participating institutes and adopted villages is available in the website of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan https://unnatbharatabhiyan.gov.in/participating_institutes.

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is inspired by the vision of transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build the architecture of an Inclusive India. Currently under the scheme UBA, 13072 villages have been adopted by 2474 Institutes. The technology interventions under the scheme Unnat Bharat Abhiyan has been able to transform the living conditions in villages. The technological interventions under the UBA cover different subjects broadly categorized like in the area of sustainable agriculture; water resource management; artisans, industries and livelihood; basic amenities (infrastructure & services) and rural energy system. With the interventions in the abovementioned areas, various new and old technologies has been developed which have transformed the living conditions in villages and has been beneficial for rural India.

Some technological interventions done under scheme UBA are; i) Mushroom Cultivation done in Gendikata cluster by IIT Delhi; ii) Environment Controlled Automated Green House For High Valued Agro Produce by HVPM College of Engineering and Technology (Amravati); iii) Safe Drinking Water by NIT Manipur and IIT Jodhpur; iv) Paper bag making by BITS Mesra; v) Pottal crockery making by NIT Hamirpur; vi) Cloth Bag making by Fatima College, Madurai; vii) Revamping of Govt. schools in Vrindavan Cluster by IIT Delhi; viii) Improved Pottery Kiln in Farrukhnagar cluster by IIT Delhi; ix) Thread winding machine for weavers by Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University, Etcherla; x) Agriculture drone system by Santhiram Engineering College, Nandyal (A.P) etc

Your participation is important for this workshop. Looking forward to meet you on 25th April at New Delhi.

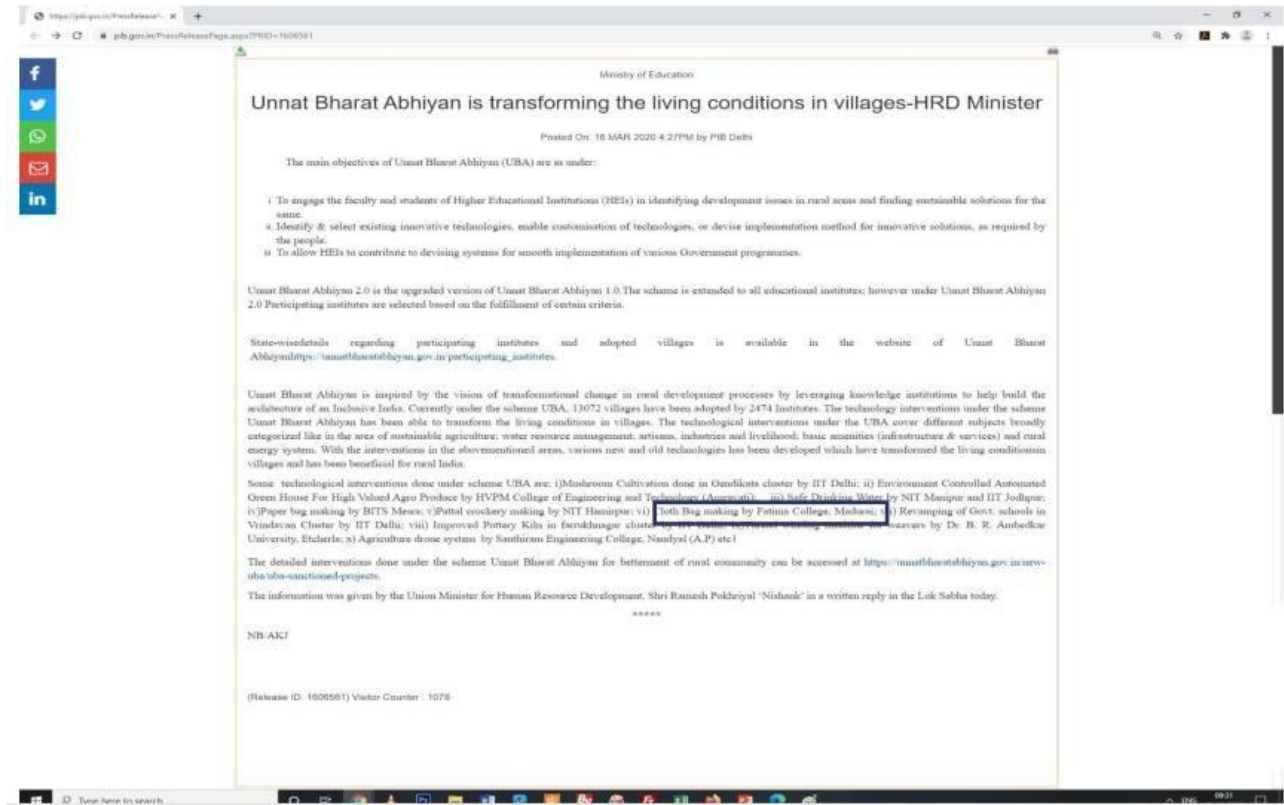

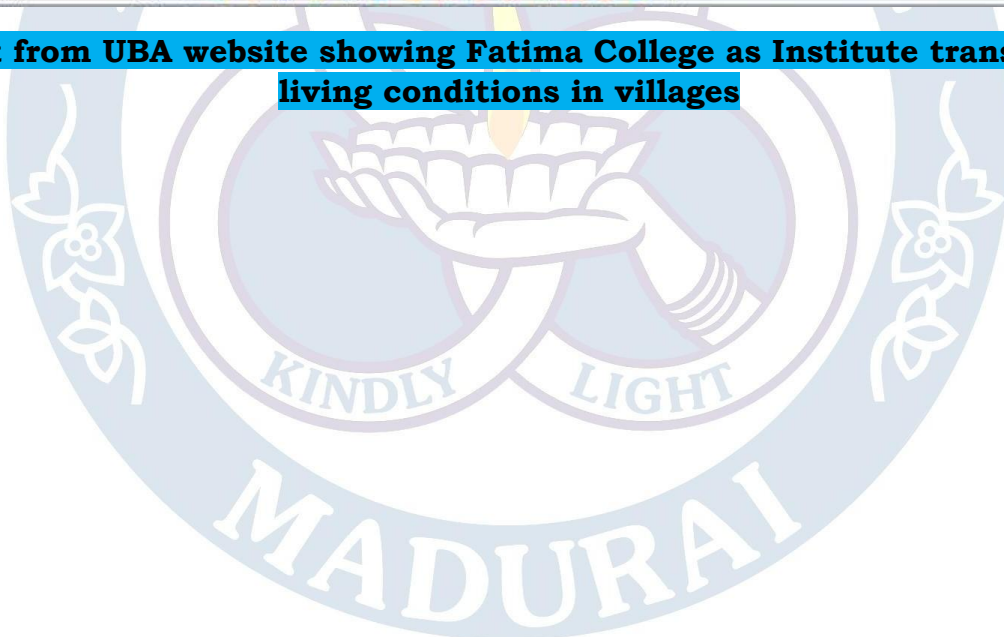

Our Institution is awarded perennial fund by Unnat Bharat Abiyan 2.0

On August 2020.

Among 2614 Institutions including all the IITs, Medical colleges and Engineering colleges selected as PIs under UBA 2.0, Fatima College is one of the Institutions to receive the perennial fund award for Swachhata activities, Jal Sakthi activities and Environmental protection activities.



Unnat Bharat Abiyan 2.0

Unnat Bharat Abiyan is a flagship programme of the Ministry of Human Resource Development with the intention to enrich Rural India. Fatima College is one of the Participating Institution under UBA- 2.0 selected in a challenge mode based on our past contribution to societal development.

As per requirement, our institution identified 5 villages namely Thirumal Natham, Nedungulam, Vadugapatti, Ambalathadi and Kondayampatti in consultation with the District Collector and have built good rapport with people. So far we have conducted Participatory Rural Appraisal and formed stake holders committee in each villages. Village survey and house hold survey has been carried out and uploaded in UBA Portal.

Faculty and Students have participated in Gram Sabha meets and addressed local issues and have under taken various activities to find solution to those problems in collaboration with villages.

Village Development Plan was prepared with Stake Holders of the respective villages. Regular activities such as Tutoring, Swachatha Activities, Jal Sakthi activates, environmental protection activities and skill trainings are carried out on a regular rhythm. Initially during the year 2018-2019 Our Institution received Rs.50000/- as seed money to carry out survey related activities.

For Second Phase during January 2020, our Institution applied for Perennial fund which is provided to those institutions who are participating in multiple development work or projects in the villages through regular visits. Selection is done on merit basis based on the evaluation of the progress report of PIs.



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We are happy to know that our Institution is awarded perennial fund of 1.75 lakhs by UBA for the second phase. Total 2614 institutions including all the IITs, Medical colleges and Engineering colleges are selected as PIs under UBA 2.0. 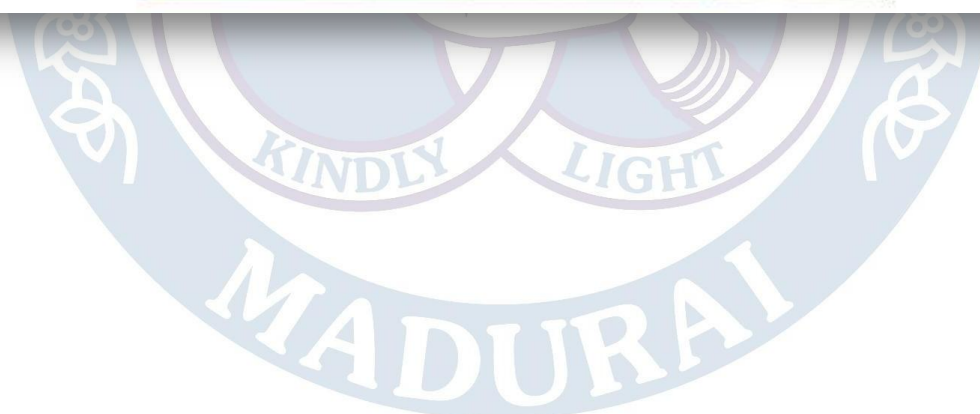
