## ABOUT THE COLLEGE



Fatima College (Autonomous), Mary Land, Madurai, is a Postgraduate College for women affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University. It is a Catholic minority institution established and run by St. Joseph's Society of Madurai (the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Lyon, France). This institution came into existence through the tireless efforts of the missionary sisters of St. Joseph of Lyon and the zeal and heroic sacrifice of Rev. Sr. Rose Benedicta, the Foundress of the College.

The College was started in St. Joseph's School Campus, Madurai as a Secondary Grade College with 63 students in 1953. It was upgraded into a Postgraduate College in 1964 and Autonomous in 1990. The College now offers 24 Undergraduate Programmes, 15 Postgraduate Programmes and 3 Professional Programmes (UG-1, PG-2). Eight Departments have become Research Centres.
