

The Congregation of the Sister of St. Joseph was founded in le Puy, France, in 1650 by Jean pierre Medaille in response to the situation of war, famine, social injustice, etc. It was on of the first juridical congregations of women recognized as a religious apostolic congregation by Msgr Henri de Maupas, Bishop of Le Puy en Velay.



Father **Jean-Pierre Medaille** was born in Carcassonne on October 6, 1610. He entered the Society of Jesus at Toulouse on September 15, 1626 and was ordained in the year 1637. During his missionary endeavours at St. Flour in the central region of France, he had met 'a group of widows and women', not called to the closister, but eager to consecrated to God. The new sisters lived very simply in small communities without any

distinguishing sign. They accepted any 'works of mercy, spiritual as well as corporal'. Fr. Madaille died December 30, 1669 at the college of Billom.



Mother **Jeanne Fontbonne** was born March 31, 1759, in Bas-en-Basset (haute-Loire), in a deeply Christian rural family. She was educated by the Sister of St. Joseph at Bas, then at Le Puy, receiving a solid formation. Mother Jeanne Fontbonne made her profession on october 14, 1779 and was elected superior in 1785 at the age of 26. It was then that the community suffered the effects of the Revolution and was dispersed. In 1808,

Mother St. John was called to form a group of sister in St. Etienne. While Mother St. John was Superior General, the Congregation of Lyons spread over 13 Departments (districts) of France, into Italy and across the sea. She spent her last years at the Mother House of the 'rue des Cheartreux' where 'her customary serenity and gentleness remained with her until her death' on November 22, 1843.

As Sister of St. Joseph of Lyons, we are present in different parts of the World having 205 houses. In India, Sisters are present both in the North and South hemisphere involved in various ministries. We reach out to the powerless children, youth and rural women and empower them with true dignity to be in the main stream of the society.

COLLEGE PROFILE

Fatima College, Mary Land, Madurai, is a Post Graduate College for women affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University. It is a Catholic Minority institution established and run by St. Joseph's Society of Madurai (of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Lyons, France). This institution came into existence through the tireless efforts of the missionary sisters of St. Joseph of Lyons and the zeal and heroic sacrifice of Rev.Sr.Rose Benedicta, the Foundress of the College.

The College was started in St. Joseph's Campus Madurai as a Second Grade College with 63 students in 1953. The College was upgraded and become a Post Graduate College in 1964 and Autonomous in 1990. The College now offers 20 Under Graduate Courses, 14 Post Graduate Courses, 2 Professional courses, 5 M.Phil. Courses and 4 Departments have become Research Centres. It has a strength of 4768 students, 195 Teaching Staff and 96 Non-Teaching Staff.

The Comprehensive assessment by NAAC in 1999 placed Fatima College in Five Star Status of merit. The College strives to sustain excellence, quality and relevance while equipping the students to meet the demands of higher education in India. In 2004 UGC conferred on Fatima College the status of College with Potential for Excellence. In 2006 and 2013 NAAC Re-Accredited and honoured the college with 'A' Grade.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Fatima College has designed a Student-Centred Curriculum and introduced Choice Based Credit System which has provided the opportunity to make radical curricular modifications offering Inter Disciplinary Optional Papers / Subjects from one's own and other Departments, and Diploma / Certificate Courses for all students. The curriculum is designed to focus on a wholesome education that is need Based, Value / Ethic Based, Job / Career Based and Research-based. Computer Based Papers are offered by all departments. In order to stimulate research skill, projects are made mandatory to the final year students. Hands on training through Internship and Exposure programmes are offered by most departments. The general characteristic of change in syllabus is according to local relevance, Vocational Skills and Applied Aspects.

The Examination System

Autonomy was conferred on Fatima College in 1990. The system of evaluation has been systematically and periodically remodeled to make it highly credible and valid. There has been a parallel evolution of evalution system to match the changing trends in curricular innovations and teaching learning methodologies.

The basis of changes incorporated in the question paper pattern and evaluation components are aimed at comprehensive evaluation of the capabilities of the students. The evaluation pattern is constructed to test the textual comprehension and practical application of knowledge gained in various areas of their chosen subjects. Hence credits and marks are allotted for projects, internships and training programmes.

The current system of evaluation is based on the CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) guidelines given by the Department of Higher Education, Tamil Nadu Government.

The two components of the evaluation are:

CIA (Continuous Internal Assessment) = 25% ESE(End Semester Examination) = 75%

CIA

The common requisites for CIA are as follows:

- Two centralized and mandatory tests
- ♦ Quiz
- ♦ Assignment

The dates for the two mandatory tests are given in the Calendar and Handbook issued to every student. The test dates are usually not changed, it is the responsibility of every student to write both the tests without fail. Retest is not offered as a rule. If a student is absent for either of the tests, the available marks will be divided by two and taken as the test mark for that paper.

A student who is absent for a test on medical grounds, has to apply to the Principal, through the Head of the department for special permission to write retest.

ESE

The date of the commencement of the End Semester Examinations is printed in the College Calendar. The detailed Time Table for regular and supplementary papers will be published in the College Website at least three weeks before the beginning of the examinations. A copy of the time table will be displayed in the notice board also. It is the responsibility of every student to note down the specific dates and time for all the papers she is appearing for.

Candidates who have passed with repeated attempts are not eligible for Distinction.

SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION FOR ARREARS

Aggregate pass minimum 40/100 = 40%

Current students and private candidates can appear <u>for any paper</u> <u>in any end semester examination of April / November</u>. The July supplementary examination will be only for the arrears in the final semester papers of April end semester examination of outgoing students.

Contact the college administrative office regarding registration for these supplementary examinations. Check the college website for the time table of these examinations. Application forms for writing supplementary examination should be signed by the Head of the Department. Xerox copy of the last received Mark Sheet should be attached to the application form.

Number of attempts allowed for Passing in the same syllabus

1+4 chances are allowed for any paper in the same syllabus. After that, the candidates can write the examination only in current syllabus. Students, who have exhausted the allowed chances, must contact the H.O.D and register for the current equivalent paper only. The date for registration of supplementary examinations is printed on the college calendar and ten working days are allowed for registering.

Late submission of application forms for registration will not be permitted.

For all examinations, the students' Identity Card (ID CARD) should be presented as Hall Ticket. If ID card is lost, the candidate must apply for replacement to the Vice Principal.

REVALUATION OF ANSWER PAPER

Students who have **failed** and wish to apply for revaluation, should contact the college administrative office within 7 working days after the publication of results, to get the application form and details of fee for revaluation. Revaluation results will be forwarded to their home address within ten days after the last day allowed for applying for revaluation.

C.I.A REPEATS (for improving INTERNAL marks only).

A student who has passed in the external examination but has failed because of getting less than the aggregate minimum 40/100 (U.G) or 50/100(P.G), can apply for this provision at the beginning of any semester.

CIA improvement can be attempted in any semester for any paper. The students must contact the administrative office at the beginning of each semester to register for CIA improvement for odd / even semester papers. After registering and duly paying the fees, she should keep in contact with the Department and get to know the dates of the Tests, Quiz and Assignment.

MALPRACTICE DURING END SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

Malpractice (possession of papers or any other material with hints/copying/insertion of prewritten answer paper) will be severely punished. If you find any incriminating material (bits of papers with hints) near your seat, report immediately to the Hall Supervisor. Those who commit Malpractice will have to face an enquiry committee consisting of the Principal, Controller, Dean and HOD, with her parents, who will be informed of the nature of punishment i.e.

First time offence - Cancellation of examination taken in the particular paper. The candidate will be debarred from appearing for that paper for one subsequent examination.

Repeat offence - Cancellation of examination of all subjects registered for that session. The candidate will be debarred for these papers for one subsequent examination.

MALPRACTICE DURING CENTRALIZED TESTS First time offence

If a student indulges in malpractice either during T1 or T2 for the first time in her period of study, the test will stand cancelled and no marks will be awarded for that paper. During consolidation of marks for that paper, the available mark will be divided by 2, and taken as test average.

Repeat offence

If a student indulges in malpractice either during T1 or T2 for the second time in her period of study, all the tests she had written in that schedule will be cancelled and no marks will be awarded

for any of the papers. During consolidation of marks for all papers, the BOARDS: available mark for one test will be divided by 2, and taken as test average

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

ATTENDANCE:

- Regularity in attendance is obligatory in Fatima College.
- Candidates shall have 80% of minimum attendance per Semester to take the Semester Examination.
- Candidates who have less than 80% of attendance, but above 65% shall pay 50/- as per university rule, towards condonation fee.
- Those students who have less than 65% of attendance will have to repeat the Semester after completing the course.
- Students involved in Extra-curricular Activities shall contact the respective authorities who will seek the prior permission from the Principal (Warden in the case of resident students) for attendance,

LEAVE:

- Students should apply for leave only on the prescribed leave application appended to the College Calendar.
- In case of absence due to unforeseen cause, leave letter should be submitted to the class teacher on the first day of returning to the College.
- If leave is requested for reasons of sickness for more than two days. the leave application should be submitted along with the Medical Certificate.
- Continued absence without leave application will render a student liable to have her name struck off the rolls.
- Please Note: Submission of Leave Application with / without Medical Certificate does not entitle a student to earn attendance iutomatically for the days of her absence from the College.

MESTER FEES REGULATIONS:

In order to enhance the quality of institutional management, the icademic year is divided into two Semesters and each Semester consists of minimum of 90 working days without counting the test days and Exam days.

Semester fees shall be paid without fine within 10 working days and ARY RULES with fine within 30 days from the date of reopening of each semestime Absence from College with or without leave will not be considered as at excuse for late payment.

If the Semester fees is not paid within 30 days after the re-opening the student's name shall be struck off the rolls of the college. It readmitted she shall pay a re-admission fee in addition to the fees and fine

Every student shall pay the Semester fees due even if shi discontinues before completing the Semester. If a student leaves the college during the Semester, she shall not have the right to claim remission of any portion of the fees.

If a scholarship holder leaves the College during the Semester shi will not get the scholarship even if the money is sanctioned, as it will be returned to the scholarship source.

NO DUES:

Clearance of attendance fees due is a prerequisite for:

- 1. Permission to write the Semester Exams.
- 2. Getting Transfer Certificate from the College.

CERTIFICATE:

- A former or present student desiring to obtain a certificate (transfer age, character, bonafide, etc) shall apply for it, by making a formal writter request to the Principal.
- A Certificate will not generally be issued in less than 24 hours notice.




