Life is always colourful with varied experiences along with many facets of blessings and success. Life at home is formed by blood bonded relationship that is natural. Another successful year has passed in the history of Fatima College Hostel. We have 980 energetic and young women residing in the hostel. They hail from 23 districts of Tamilnadu, few students are from Kerala and Maharastra. We are also happy to have six students from Srilanka with us. This is the first year that we given accommodation for five students who are doing their Diploma in Lab Technician in WEAT, The Women Empowerment And Training, a wing of Fatima College.

The hostel administration is mainly managed by Sr. Bindu, Sr. Victoria, Sr. Biji, Sr.Vinnerasi and Sr. Jenita assisted by Ms.Shobhana, Ms.Ramya and Ms. Uma Maheswari. The office bearers, Deepthy JR – III B.A. English, Riolin – II BSc Physics, Jerusha – II MSW and Amalu Sathesh – I BSc Physics along with the wardens enhance the smooth functioning of the hostel. They act as link between the students and the administration and facilitate better relationship between the administration and students community. Day to day decisions, related to the life of the hostel is taken in consultation with them, ensuring collective and concerted decision making process.

Fatima Hostel creates an excellent milieu for the rural and economically poor students, particularly the first generation learners to excel in their academics. 170 deserving students have been given concession for the hostel fee this year to the tune of Rs.15,50000/- . I am grateful to all my hostel committee members for supporting the cause of the poor. We also find some benefactors who are generously help the poor

students financially and number poor students benefit out of it. Our sincere thanks to all of them.

The beginning of academic year we were welcomed with a beautiful prayer service by the Liturgy Committee. It helped us to start the academic year with the blessings of God. On July 7th 2017 we had a Holy Spirit Mass celebrated by Rev.Fr.Yesu Karuna and Rev.Fr.Ignaci, followed by the blessings of hostel buildings. We start our day imploring the presence of God through devotional songs played in the early morning through intercom, followed by a short prayer and we end our day with a short prayer at 10.00pm. At 8.30 pm we have hostel prayer followed by announcements during which the names of the birthday babies are read out and they are greeted with affection. A minute of silent prayer is prayed for various intention of the world. Students pray the Rosary every evening in devotion to mother Mary. Special prayer services are conducted on special occasions like Diwali, Christmas, Pongal and on birthdays of sisters. On the first Friday of every month our students conduct the adoration in a meaningful way in which the majority of the hostellers are present irrespective of their religion. On October 7th on the feast of Our Lady of Rosary, a special Rosary was conducted in which the students went around the hostel campus praying Rosary. The students participated with full involvement and the campus was filled with God's presence.

Acknowledging the varies services rendered by the students, an outing was organised for all the committee members and representatives to Kodaikanal on 5th november 2017. It was an enjoyable experience to all. It also deepened our relationship with one another. We are grateful to thankful to our sisters for arranging this outing.

The students cherish the warm, homely and friendly atmosphere in the hostel. The directors of hostel take special individual and personal care not only to provide the physical needs of the students but also take care of the psychological and spiritual needs. This is done by offering counselling and guidance to the students. The students are met by the directors in charge periodically in order to build a cordial relationship with each other and remind them their responsibilities as fatimites. During this academic year many need based and inspirational talks were arranged to help us lead a better and healthier life. An inspirational talk to motivate the youth was held on 8th August 2017 by Rev Dr.Joe Arun SJ, Director, Josephs Institute of Management, Tirchy. He spoke on various social issues that demand women of today to be independent and empowered. He also said that the wisdom and the experience of the parents needs to be listened to, which will lead us in the right path. There was an awareness cum input session on “manual scavenging” on 22nd August 2017, by Rev Fr .Philomin Raj who is a social activist & Lawyer. Father began the session with spotting light on the ignorance of people towards a particular section of society who keeps the city clean. He also stressed on the importance of self cleanliness. As a part of session a documentary film “thotti” was screened, which helps us to realise the pain that scavengers undergo.

We learned to respect them and to take responsibility for cleanliness. The house keeping staff who are working in our hostel were honoured with a shawl, acknowledging their great service. An awareness program on dengue was organized on 20th October 2017, by Rev. Sr. Victoria and Sr. Marcy who are professional nurses. They briefly explained about the symptoms and cause of denku and the preventive measures. . Sr.Fatima Antony, former Principal of Fatima College, presently involved in the Prison ministry, gave an inspiring talk on character formation. Live a life with good values, that only can give ultimate happiness. We were touched by her inspiring sharing with life experience. She asked us to be women of substance and not just be women of flesh and blood.

Monitored study hours of the students and continual follow-up of their scores in internals and externals help our students to excel academically. During this academic year 12 students have scored first rank, 6 students scored second rank and 4 students have scored third rank in their studies in first, third and fifth semesters respectively. Around 34 students from hostel are placed through campus placement in various companies and schools.

Facilities

The hostel provides a serene atmosphere and clean surroundings to the students for their study and stay. For the entertainment of the students there is home theatre connected with Tata sky. One more rainwater sump is constructed connecting the entire hostel building. A new generator is purchased. A new bore well is dug and good water source is found. Mosquito mesh is fixed in Annuciata and Marrita block. To ensure the safe and secured stay of students, CCTV cameras are fixed in each block. Four more Acqua water plant has been installed to provide good drinking water. Extra cots were purchased to accommodate the students in Marritta block.

Co-Workers

Regular meeting with staff members enable them to have better understanding and bring out their best into their area of work. Prayer is conducted regularly for the staff, which help them to grow in God consciousness. On 15th of November, an outing cum pilgrimage to Velakanni was organized for all the staff members. It was a day of

refreshment and relaxation and it helped them to deepen the relationship with one another. Dengue awareness program was given to the staff.
