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Academic Council Report - 2014

The Academic Council Meeting of Fatima College for the year 2014 was held on 17th June. The meeting started with a prayer by Sr. P.A.Mary. After the prayer, the principal of Fatima College welcomed the special invitees for the meeting. The experts are from other colleges and institutions. The esteemed guests who attended the meeting are Dr Daniel Chellappa, Senior Scientist, and Technical Co-ordinator of Bhabha Atomic Research centre, Department of Atomic Energy, Tamil Nadu. Mr. Nasimalai, Director of DHAN Foundation, Dr. Fr. Xavier Vedam, Principal of Arulanandar College, Dr. Poovaryagi, Principal of Yadhava Women's College, Madurai. All the Heads of the Departments of our college were present along with controller of Examinations, Deans and student representatives.

Starting with the History Department, the Heads of all the departments explained the changes and suggestions given in their Board of Studies Meeting, that was held during the month of May. First the experts listened to the reports read by the Heads of the Departments of Regular Courses. Then the Heads of Self-financing Courses read out their reports. Then the special invitees clarified their doubts and made some suggestions.

- * Dr. Francis Xavier Vedam suggested to introduce modern theories in Sociology syllabi.
- * He also suggested to include the reference books in addition to the text book.
- * Dr. Geetha explained about the revamping of the

is syllabi by focussing on listening, speaking, reading writing] LSRW method.

- * Framing of General Tamil syllabus is clarified as mainly focussing on speaking, spelling, pronunciation, writing and creativity.
- * Dr. Daniel Chellappa, Senior Scientist of Bhabha Atomic Research centre stressed the importance of research.
- * He also explained overview of the Atomic Energy usage in various fields.
- * Mr. Vasimalai highlighted that the Academic Council Meeting should be highly interactive about the relevance and aptitude of different subjects with the experts and the staff of various departments.

A Student representative from B.Sc., Computer Science shared her views about the syllabus which is up to date and beneficial. Finally the vote of thanks was given by Sr. Fatima Mary Sociology Department. She expressed her sincere thanks and gratitude to the special invitees, the principal, Controllers, Deans and Staff of Fatima College.
