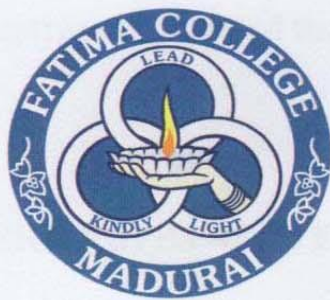

2014. Ramzan was celebrated on 28th July 2014. The college put on a festive look on 23rd December 2014 for Christmas celebration. Carol singing competition was held and the winners were the students of the Department of Commerce. The New Year dawned with new hope and aspiration.
