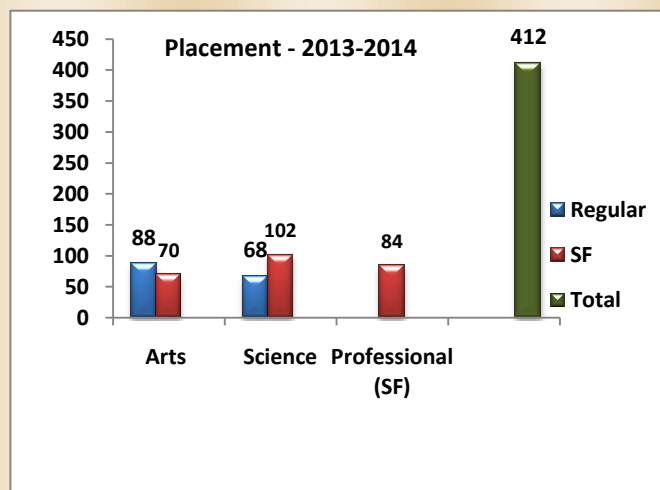
INSTITUTE - INDUSTRY INTERFACE CELL
