About College

Fatima College (Autonomous), Mary Land, Madurai, is a Post Graduate and Research Institution for Women affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University. It is a Catholic minority Institution, established and run by the sisters of St. Joseph's Society of Lyons (of the Congregation of the of St. Joseph of Lyon, France). The College was started in St. Joseph's Campus Madurai as a Second Grade College with 63 students in 1953. It was upgraded into a Post Graduate College in 1964; Autonomous in 1990 and a Research Institute in 2004. The College now offers 21 Undergraduate Programmes, 14 Postgraduate Programmes, 2 Professional Programmes and 6 Departments have become Research Centres. It has strength of 4062 Students, 199 Teaching Staff and 89 Non-Teaching Staff. It has strength of 4012 students. In 2021-2022 NAAC re-accredited the college with 'A++' Grade with CGPA of 3.61 on a 4-point scale.

About Library

Rosa Mystica Library is an integral part of the Fatima College's network and contributes to its moral purpose of transformative and enriching education and research. The library providing quality library learning environment and services which contribute to the student experience beyond the formal learning experience. Rosa Mystica Library has a distinctive role within the campus, providing precise and quality information facilities, services and resources to benefit the learning, teaching and research experiences of Fatima students and staff. Library has served the user community with 135000 volumes of Books, 250000+ E- Journals, 270000+E-Books, 105 Journals and Magazines, 1400 Dissertations and thesis. It also subscribed the Anti-Plagiarism tool Drill bit to evaluate the projects and dissertations. Library has 172 Braille Books, Jaws software, 98 Talking books for visually challenged students.
